

Playroom Rules

- 1. Consent is Mandatory:** No touching without explicit consent. The fact that someone is present does not automatically mean you get to have sex with them.
- 2. Enthusiastic and Ongoing Consent:** No means no. Only an enthusiastic yes means yes. Consent can be withdrawn at any time for any reason. If someone becomes non-verbal, assume consent is withdrawn and check in. "NO" ALWAYS MEANS NO.
- 3. Hygiene and Cleanliness:** Practice excellent personal hygiene. Use the provided cleaning supplies to wipe down surfaces, toys, and equipment after you use them. Do not engage in activities if you have a known contagious infection.
- 4. Prohibited Activities:** No scat, watersports, needle play, or blood play. This is a non-negotiable rule for health and safety reasons.
- 5. Substance Use:** Alcohol is permitted only in moderation. Anyone who appears intoxicated will be asked to leave. Use of other substances that impair judgment is strongly discouraged.
- 6. Safer Sex is Your Responsibility:** It is up to you and your partner(s) to decide whether or not to use barriers (condoms, dental dams, gloves).
- 7. Personal Toys:** Feel free to bring your own toys. Please ask before using them on someone else, and clean them before and after use.
- 8. Scene Etiquette:** Do not intrude on someone else's scene without being explicitly invited. Watch from a respectful distance and do not interrupt or join in.
- 9. Respect Boundaries:** Do not pressure anyone to do anything they are not comfortable with. Do not ask repeatedly after being turned down.
- 10. Singles:** Singles or solo's (Male or female) must be accompanied or invited into the room.
- 11. Discretion and Privacy:** What happens in the playroom stays in the playroom. Do not take photos, videos, or recordings of any kind. Do not identify other participants outside of this space.
- 12. No Drama:** This is a space for mutual pleasure, not for resolving personal conflicts. Take any interpersonal issues outside.
- 13. Clean Up After Yourself:** Dispose of all trash, condoms, and wrappers in the designated bins. Leave the space cleaner than you found it.
